PART VII. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF PENNSYLVANIA COURTS [204 PA. CODE CH. 207] Transmitting Remittances

By Order of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania of October 14, 1988, Judicial Administration Docket No. 88, the Court Administrator has been delegated the authority under the Judicial Code, 42 Pa.C.S. § 3502(c)(3), to adjust, through regulation, the level of fines, costs, fees and other remittances as otherwise fixed by law so as to facilitate the transmission of remittances through or by a financial intermediary.

In accordance therewith, the regulation filed by the Court Administrator on March 20, 2006 relating to the adjustments of fines, costs, fees and other remittances is hereby amended, in the following form. See 204 Pa. Code § 207.2.

CHAPTER 207. TRANSMITTING REMITTANCES

- § 207.2. Philadelphia [Traffic Court] Municipal Court Traffic Division—Adjustment of Fines, Costs, Fees and Other Remittances.
- (a) Pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 3502(c)(3), the Court Administrator of Pennsylvania hereby adjusts the level of fines, costs, fees and other remittances in all cases under the Motor Vehicle Code (Title 75, Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes) and local ordinances prosecuted in the Philadelphia [Traffic Court] Municipal Court Traffic Division by increasing such costs, fees and other remittances to the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per citation or traffic violation report. Said amount shall be paid to a contracting financial intermediary and shall be added to the fines, costs, fees and other remittances at such time as the Philadelphia [Traffic Court] Municipal Court Traffic Division sends or causes to be served a written notice other than a summons to a defendant.
- (b) This regulation shall become effective April 1, 2006, and shall apply to all citations and traffic violation reports filed [with the Traffic Court] prior to that date.

CHAPTER 69. INTERNAL OPERATING PROCEDURES OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT OF PENNSYLVANIA

ORIGINAL JURISDICTION

§ 69.341. Process; Designation of Officials for Service of Process.

[The Sheriff of Dauphin County is the official agency designated to execute service of process issuing from the court, either directing in Dauphin County or by deputizing the respective sheriffs of other counties, for the service of process in those other counties.]

The Commonwealth Court is a court of Statewide jurisdiction. Therefore, for purposes of Pa.R.C.P. No. 400(d), an action commenced in this court is deemed commenced in all counties of this Commonwealth. Accordingly, where service is to be effectuated within this Commonwealth by a sheriff, the sheriff of any county where service may be made is authorized to serve process issuing from this court and does not need to be deputized.

§ 69.342. Process; Designation of Officials for Execution of Bench Warrants of Arrest.

By order in a particular case, a judge may designate the Pennsylvania State Police or [the Sheriff of Dauphin County] the sheriff of any county where the bench warrant may be executed as the official agency for the execution of a bench warrant of arrest. [The Sheriff of Dauphin County may act either directly, within Dauphin County, or by deputizing sheriffs of other counties.]
